The Rydges Hotel has the main entrance in 389 Pitt St. There is also an entrance in Liverpool St.

Conference Transport Options

For most people, public transport is cheapest and easiest. You can get a free Opal card that you can load with funds to use on trains, buses, ferries and light rail. There are also single tickets that can be bought from convenience stores, but these are full adult fares or child tickets only.

If you want an Opal Card, it is best to get one online before you come, especially for interstate visitors and those wanting a gold seniors Opal card. For more information: www.opal.com.au/en/get-an-opal-card/

By Train

From **Town Hall Station** it's a 10 minute walk (500 metres). Exit Town Hall Station, walk south along George Street, turn left into Liverpool Street, take the escalator up to level 1 from Liverpool Street.

From **Museum Station** it's a 5 minute walk (200 metres). Exit Museum Station, walk south along Elizabeth Street, turn right into Liverpool Street and take the escalator up to level 1 from Liverpool Street

From **Central Station** it's a 15 minute walk (800 metres). From the country platforms, walk down the ramp over Eddy Avenue. From the suburban platforms, cross Eddy Avenue and walk through Belmore Park. Both lead to the intersection of Hay and Pitt Street. Walk north up Pitt Street and enter Rydges from Pitt Street.

By Bus

The closest buses travel along Pitt, Castlereagh or Elizabeth Streets. **Alight at the closet stop to Liverpool Street.** The walk should take no more than 5 minutes (up to 200 metres).

Light Rail (Tram)

Runs from Central Station to Chinatown, Darling Harbour and The Star casino. It then goes as far as Dulwich Hill on a less frequent timetable. Catch it two blocks down the hill from Rydges in Day St.

Car Parking Options

AT THE RYDGES WORLD SQUARE HOTEL: Stop at the hotel's entrance, located at 389 Pitt Street, where the valet car parking team will attend to you. Self-parking is not permitted. Cost is \$60 per day (24 hours).

The private parking companies listed below control most of the public parking options near Rydges. It is best to go their website to book.
